Endangered Species Act Consultations

ACPs must include names/contact info for reps from FWS & National Marine Fisheries Service & parameters of when to call them. ACPs must include list of federally threatened & endangered species in AOR & list appropriate organization to consult with.

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Essential Fish Habitats (EFH) Consultations

ACPs must include a list of EFHs & Habitat Areas of Particular Concern within the geographical area covered.

ACPs must contain names & contact info for EFH representatives.

Historic Preservation Act

Compliance & Pre-Spill Coord

- As part of ACP planning activities, FOSCs must engage with State Historic Preservation Officers, federal land managing agencies, and Federally Recognized Tribes.
 - ID previously recorded historic & cultural resources.
 - ID locations of specific historic properties that have been listed as eligible for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places.
 - Develop list of parties to be notified in the event of an incident.
 - ID names & contact info for Historic Property Specialists, State Historic Preservation Officers, Tribal Historic Preservation Officers & any applicable Tribal organizations for prespill & emergency consultation notifications.
