

# Mission Areas:

- Prevention** - The capabilities necessary to avoid, prevent, or stop a threatened or actual act of terrorism within the U.S.
  
- Protection** - The capabilities to secure the homeland against acts of terrorism and manmade or natural disasters
  
- Mitigation** - The capabilities necessary to reduce loss of life and property by lessening the impact of disasters
  
- Response** - The capabilities necessary to save lives, protect property and the environment, and meet basic human needs after an incident has occurred
  
- Recovery** - The capabilities necessary to help communities affected by an incident in recovering effectively


